amount nor the cement have been supplied by the above-named Company during the year.

[Delhi office is being asked to submit a detailed report over the issue on top priority basis.]

Leave Salary AIC, 630

An amount of Rs. 37,613.00 have been paid against Leave Salary, out of which Rs. 9,143.00 have been paid against order from the H.O., the basis and mode of which is not available at the Delhi Centre and the balance amounting to Rs. 28,470.00 have been paid on ad-hoc basis. But the above payments relates to earlier years for which no provision was made.

[The grant on this account is released by the Government of India in the phased manner which was also known to auditor.]

Liability not provided for

As per the decision of the Institute to pay the Leave Salary for earlier year (vide letter No. C 2110/A/cs dated 13.8-76), the liability arrived at by Delhi Branch for its R.T.S. Staff amounts to Rs. 1,40,000.00, out of which Rs. 28,470.00 has been paid on ad-hoc basis. The balance amount Rs. 1,11,530.00 has not been provided by the Delhi Centre.

Contingent Liability

The Institute is contingently liable to pay M/s. Associated Builders Rs. 304,510.33 in addition to the interest on the above @6%p.a. from the date of award of arbritration arising out of the award given by the arbitrator to pay the above-named company against its claims to 1.S.1., Delhi,

The arbritrators have filed the award in the Delhi High Court and the same is being contested by the Institute before the Hon'ble Delhi High Court.

[Contingent liability already provided in the Balance Sheet by way of foot note.]

Capital Commitments: Contract remaining to be executed amounting to Rs. 94,406.00 (Previous year Rs. 2,03,941.00)

[No comment]

Materials at Site: The Institute is paying 80% of value as an advance against the materials at Site as on the date of different running bills brought by contractors. In the absence of any records at the work site, it was not possible for us to verify the correctness as to materials remaining at site on different dates.

We have suggested in our last two years' report that the proper records should be maintained for materials brought in and consumed by contractors, since the above payment have been made on a secured Advance for which the Institute has lien over the materials at Site. However, no such records have been maintained during the year under audit.

[The suggestion of the auditors will be acted upon in future by the Delhi office]

I.C.S.S.R. (Project) Fellowship

An amount of Rs. 88,196.90 have been shown as expenses incurred by the Institute since 1973-74 which is to be reimbursed by the I.C.S.S.R., but up to March, 1975, the Institute has received Rs. 23,338.00 only. In our opinion, the matter should be looked into by the authority for earlier realisation of the same.

[Steps are being taken to recover the amount at an early date.]

Difference on account of Realisation from Contractors against Materials supplied to them.
(Steel & Cement)

In the course of our verification, it was found that the amount realised from Contractors is short of the amount of the value of the Materials supplied which are as follows:

Annexure 2

Re: Audit of Giridih Branch for the year ending 1975-76

We have audited the Trial Balance as at 31st March, 1976 of the Indian Statistical Institute, Giridih Branch, and subsequent to our discussion at Head Office, Baranagar, we submit our observation below:

1. Fixed Assets

(a) Land & Building

The Institute owns the following land and Building at Giridih:

- (i) Rose Villa
- (ii) Prakriti Davi Ganguly's land
- (iii) Farm land
- (iv) Health Home, and
- (v) Biroja Kuthi.

In course of our verification of land deeds, it was noticed that the title-deeds of Rose Villa and Prakriti Devi Ganguly's land are still lying with the court for which no settlement has been made as yet. However, the certified copy of the two above land deeds have been produced before us.

[No comments. However, we have already advised Giridih office to expedite the court case.]

(b) Furniture & Fixture: Though a physical verification as well as marking has been made as at 31st March 1976 but no shortage/damage could be verified by us for reasons stated in the Head Office reports.

[No comments except that an outside agency has already been appointed for conducting physical verification and compiling asset register and they have submitted that preliminary report. However, we cannot agree with the auditors' observation since they have already received a certificate for damage and broken furniture from Giridih office as mentioned in their report for 1974-75. Moreover, there is no addition in the asset for 1975-76.]

2. Stocks and Stores in hand:

In connection with this and with reference to the previous year's report, we mention that there has been practically no utilisation of surplus building materials and electrical littings lying in stores since 31.3.72. We are not satisfied with the valuation of such stocks and stores (which are shown as per book value) as some building materials and electrical goods have been damaged or

destroyed. In this regard we opine that the valuation of such stocks and stores should be valued by a qualified valuer and provision for damage/shortage should be provided in the accounts.

Regarding purchase of stocks and stores materials, we also report that most of the purchases have been made from Gupta Press and Bihar Iron Hardware Stores without following the normal procedure of purchases as laid down by the Institute.

[Necessary action will be initiated on the basis of recommendation of a special committee already set up and the decision of the Council thereof. Noted for future guidance.]

(a) Payment for rented premises: No rent agreements have been produced before us for our verification. No provision for rent (Rs. 1,320)- P.a.) of "Bagha Kuthir" has been provided since 1971-72 and up to the date of our audit due to some dispute between the owners. However, the Municipal tax and ground rent for the abovementioned premises have been paid by the Institute.

[Noted. Since accounts are already finalised and audited by the auditors necessary provision will be made in the 1976-77 accounts. Had the auditors insisted upon and amounts of probable rent being provided for in the accounts, the objection would not have cropped up at all.]

(b) Rent Receivable: House rent of Golkuthi for the month of March 1976 amounting to Rs. 275/- which has been receivable from H.S.S.D. has not been provided in the account.

[Same as above]

4. Medical Expenses: An amount of Rs. 1,279/- has been paid to two compounders of the Institute for their charges for pushing injections to employees and their relatives.

In our opinion, proper register should be maintained by the compounders for calls attended by them for our verification.

[Noted for future guidance and necessary instruction has been given to Giridih office.]

(b) Medicines:

(i) No physical verification statement of medicines were made available to us for the year 1975-76 for which no satisfactory explanation was available but we have received a list of damaged and out-dated medicines duly signed by the Officer-in-charge.

[Same as above]

(ii) In the Stock Statement of 1974-75, there was a list of damaged and out-dated medicines amounting to Rs. 50.51 for which no provision has been made in the accounts.

[Same as above]

(iii) The list of medicines also contains items for which employees are not eligible. We were given to understand that such medicines are purchased and issued to patients and afterwards realised from patients. It is suggested that the Institute should look into the matter to decide whether inadmissible medicines should be purchased at all.

[Same as above]

5. Farm land

A certificate duly signed by the Officer-in-charge for the expenses and sale proceeds of rice, wheat, etc. has been produced before us. Such crops were sold to employees and some portion of rice, wheat, etc. amounting to Rs. 351.88 have been kept for seeds for the coming season. But such portion of wheat, rice, etc. have not taken been in the stock.

[Suggestion noted and shall be adhered to in future. However, report of this small thing may be avoided in future when Institute or its officials have never placed any objection to act upon the auditors suggestion for making necessary adjustment.]

6. Library and Reading Room

No list of books as on 31st March 1976 was available for verification. Such verification was last made in 1970. No books have been purchased by the branch during the year. However, the branch received books from Barranagar, Calcutta, for which is no record is maintained. The branch is not maintaining any record for issue and receipt of books to and from the employees. No satisfactory explanation was available in this regard.

[Necessary instruction has been given to Giridih office.]

7. Cash-in-hand

We have verified the cash-in-hand as on 19.11.76 at Giridih branch and found the same to be correct.

INDIAN STATISTICAL INSTITUTE CONTRIBUTORY PROVIDENT FUND

AUDITORS' REPORT

We report that we have audited the Balance Sheet as at 31st March, 1976, of the Indian Statistical Institute Contributory Provident Fund, signed by us under reference to this report, and relative Income and Expenditure Account for the year ended on that date, with the books and records of the fund maintained by the Institute and produced to us and information and explanations given, and subject to the remarks mentioned below, have found them to be in accordance with.

1. The ISI CPF Rules, 1975, has come into force, since the first day of April, 1975. From a perusal of the Rules, the following lacunae are noticed;

Nowhere in the rules, it has been stated that, the ISI CPF Rules, 1975, will include or absorb, the assets and liabilities of the existing Provident Fund, as well as the members of the old Fund. Further, the definition of 'dependant', in respect of female members, where such member expresses her desire to exclude her dependants, is not clear. Attention is drawn to these lacunae, which may kindly be rectified.

- Interim Relief paid to workers during 1971, from which deductions were made on account of PF, are shown separately.
- 3. Liability on account of PF dues with interest to employees, include liability to employees of ISI as well as employees of NSSO who now do not belong to ISI. It may be mentioned in connection herewith that, NSSO, a Government Organisation, was separated from ISI on and from 1st June, 1972, but the settlement of PF dues have not been shown separately in the Balance Sheet of ISI-CPF.

In our opinion, steps should be taken in this regard.

- 4. In course of our routine checking, the following departures from regularity were observed:
 - (a) In some cases, deduction for recovery of loans were not made in equal monthly instalments
 - (b) The proceedings of the Board of Trustees meetings are not written in the Minutes Book, but are typed/written and pasted on the Minute Book;
 - (c) In certain cases, deduction for recovery of loans, do not increase, in spite of additional advance. On the other hand, in certain cases, the deductions were decreasing;
 - (d) The house/sites purchased by members out of withdrawals from the fund have not been supported by assignment of deed in favour of the trustees as required under Rule 19 (H).

- 5. The Board of Trustees have declared the rate of interest payable to the members of 1974-75, but no entries have been made in the Members' Ledger. For 1975-76, no rate of interest has been declared. We understand that, after the accounts are audited by the auditors, the interest rate shall be declared by the Board.
- 6. The forfeited amount of employer's contribution and interest thereon, available for the disposal of the Institute under Rule 23(2), has been credited to the Income & Expenditure Account of the Fund in the year of forfeiture and has been distributed to the members as interest.
- Payments made to NSSO workers from the balance of PF money of the ex-ISI workers absorbed in NSSO, are being treated as partial transfer of their PF money to Government.
- 8. The balances extracted from Members' Ledger were not tallied with the General Ledger at the time of audit.
- 9. As per the Rules of ISI-Contributory Provident Fund, subsequent advances shall be granted to members only on clearing of all the previous advances. But we have come across subsequent advances being granted to members, before clearing previous advances.
- 10. During the year, ISI CPF has taken loan from ISI amounting to Rs. 3,72,000.00, on which no interest has accrued. To our knowledge, there is no provision in the ISI CPF Rules authorising such a practice. We have not come across a resolution in the Minute Book (of the Board of Trustees meeting), authorising the taking of such loans.
- Relief loan receivable from members amounting to Rs. 42,819.00 out of which only Rs. 59/- has been received.
 - 12. Interest accrued from NSSO workers amounting to Rs. 70,612.42, is yet to be recovered.
- 13. Holding of Meetings: As per Rule 14 (a), meeting of the Board of Trustees is to be held every two months. From the Minutes Book, it appears that no meeting has taken place in the months of July '75 and August '75. Meetings, as per the Minutes Book, were held on 21st April, 1975; 9th June 1975; 28th October 1975; 3rd December 1975 and 21st January, 1976 i.e. 5 meetings instead of six, as required under Rule 14(a) in the 1975-76 financial year.
- 14. Advances in respect of dependents' medical treatment, marriage etc. of dependents' is made before checking the "Dependents Declaration Form." In the course of our audit, we have come across cases where loans have been taken by members for the marriage etc. of dependents whose name does not appear in the said Declaration Form. Declaration Forms for a few members were not available.
