## Statement of Accounts and Auditors' Report for the Year 1977-78

### AUDITORS' REPORT

We report that we have audited the Balance Sheet as at 31st March, 1978 signed by us under reference to this report, of

- (a) Indian Statistical Institute and
- (b) Other Funds

and the annexed Income and Expenditure Accounts for the year ended on that date with the books and records maintained by the Institute and produced to us and information and explanations given and, subject to and read with the notes appearing thereon and also subject to the remarks given below have found them to be in accordance therewith.

### The remarks referred to above are:

Though National Sample Survey Unit has been separated from the Institute with
effect from 1st June 1972, the consequential changes with regard to assets and liabilities have
not taken place as yet. As such, both the Income and Expenditure Account for the year
ended 31st March 1978 and the Balance Sheet as at that date do not give a true and fair
view to the extent of this unworked out position.

[Although we have received certified copies of list of assets taken over by NSSO from ISI, we could not give any effect of the same in our assets register on account of pending final decision about the treatment of such assets especially the discrepancies between the assets handled over to them in the year 1972 and certified copies of lists of assets now supplied by NSSO. M/s. S N Guha & Co.'s report does not reflect the true picture of assets possessed by ISI on a particular date in respect of the assets in use by ISI.

#### BALANCE SHEET

### 2. Fized Assets:

(a) Asset Registers were not maintained in proper form for Land/Land Development indicating the broak-up of the constituent expenses in connection with the same.

Register for other fixed assets are being maintained from this year showing inter-alia, the written down value of the assets as on 31st March 1976 as the original cost of Assets.

[Fixed Assets Register maintained. Land/Land Development Register as per Auditors' proforma is being maintained from 1978-79. Asset Register for Land/Land Development is maintained. However, auditors have recommended the Register to be maintained in a specific form. Register is amended accordingly.]

(i) Value of Fixed assets acquired on dates prior to 31st March 1952 were taken from those appearing in the inventories prepared as on that date.

### [No comment]

(ii) No physical verification of Fixed Assets were carried out during the year under audit.

Italioised portion in brackets are the comments of the Administration on the observations made by the Auditors.

### [No comment]

(iii) An appropriate committee set up to make a detailed report regarding the obsolete/damaged/discharged assets, for taking appropriate written-off action, submitted a report on which no action has been taken as yet.

[Administration desires that the committee's report should be referred to the Council for appropriate action. Steps are being taken accordingly.]

- (b) Land: Title deeds in respect of the following Lands possessed by the Institute were not available for our verification.
- 156, 160, 165 & 166/1, Gopal Lal Tagore Road (II) 205 B. T. Road (III) 205 B. T.
   Road (IV) Delhi (V) Farm Land, Giridih (VI) Bangalore (VII) 205 B. T. Road (VIII) 153
   Gopal Lal Tagore Road (IX) 202 B. T. Road (X) In Village Makatpur, Giridirh.

Possession certificates and/or grant certificates for items (I) and (VI) were produced before us for our verification. In respect of items (VII) & (VIII), certified copies of the plan showing the area were produced, as the original possession and/or grant certificates were not available with the Institute. With regard to item (IX), the Deed of Transfer was produced. No document in respect of item (X) could be made available for our verification. It is stated that the same has been taken by a staff of the Giridih branch.

[For lands acquired through land acquisition proceedings, there cannot be any deed of purchase or any deed of lease. Only possession certificates/grant certificates are available which have been shown to auditors. From the next year, it will be shown as "Land acquired through land acquisition proceding" in the relevant schedule to Balance Sheet to satisfy audit comments.]

- (c) Library Building at Baranagar: Rs. 68.25.016.66
- (i) The building is actually in progress. Construction up to second floor of the building was completed within the year under review. The records to the extent produced to us, reveal that the construction up to second floor could not be completed within the stipulated time. The "liquidated damage" clause for "non-completion in time should be considered at the time of final payment.

### [Noted]

(ii) This amount includes Rs. 61,586.60 towards the cost of equipment for air-conditioning plant and Rs. 89,031.83 for electrical fittings.

[The amount is debited under construction head of Library Building because the budget is prepared and sanctioned by the Finance Committee, Council of the Institute and the Government.]

(iii) The above amount also includes a payment of advance of Rs. 37,000.00 to Prof. A. K. Banerjee as architect's fee and Rs. 2,040.00 as law charges in the earlier years. The decision of the Council on this issue is still awaited.

[The question was referred to for decision of the Council at its meeting held on 18.1.78. The Council, however, decided that the administration must place before it detailed background, notes and proposals for its view at a future meeting.]

### (d) Buildings at New Delhi:

An advance of Rs. 32,213,58 was paid to M/s. Bharat Oversees (P) Ltd. for supply of coment in the year 1975-78. It is observed that neither cement has been supplied nor the amount realised. This amount is doubtful of recovery. Necessary provision should have been made in the accounts.

[Provision will be made in the next year's account.]

### (e) Sheds & Structures:

(i) The written down value of sheds and structures of Re. 49,443.83 on 203 B.T. Road and 153, Gopal Lal Tagore Road, does not give a true and fair view as at 31st March 1978 as the value of the sheds and structures domoliahed, are not ascertained by the management. Steps, if any, taken by the management to ascertain the value of the demoliahed structures, was not, however, made known to us.

[Cost of materials utilised from demolished structures at this stage is not assessable. However, based on Estate Department records that the cost of sheds and structures constructed at 153 Gopal Lal Tagore Road will be assessed and the approval of the Council will be sought towards adjustment of the cost of demolished structure in order to satisfy the audit objection.]

### (f) Soviet Printing Machines:

Soviet Printing Machines (written—down value of item (M) of Schedule I of the Institute, Rs. 5,98,420.15) is being utilised by the Statistical Publishing Society. It was given by the Soviet Academy of Sciences as a gift to the Institute. The amount of Rs. 18,66,696.58 was taken as the value of the machines in the books of accounts and corresponding credit was made to the General Fund Account in 1970-71. We are advised that a few items of the machines are damaged and there are some items which are not being utilised for various reasons. The Institute has not received for the last few years any amount by way of commission on sale of English translation of Russian publications and/or share of profit (if any) receivable under the agreement with the Statistical Publishing Society.

### [No comment]

### (g) Electronic Computer at Baranagar: Rs. 4,12,250.00

This amount represents the first instalment payment to Electronic Trade & Technology Development Corporation Ltd. towards the installation cost of an Electronic Computer. This should have been shown as advance.

### [Noted for future reference]

#### 3. Investments:

Investment of different funds under the Institute stand in the name of the Indian Statistical Institute. Securities ear-marked for the specific funds have been disclosed in the respective fund balance sheet.

[All investments other than those of Provident Fund stand in the name of the Institute.]

4. Advance on account of I.S.I.J.U. Expenditure on joint project etc.: Rs. 7,71,325.61.

- (i) The project has since been declared closed. Nocessary adjustments towards apportionment of Assots/Liabilities and Income/Expenditure have not been made in the accounts. In the absence of a confirmatory letter, the accuracy of the advance of Rs. 7.71,325.61 could not be verified.
- (ii) It is understood that in connection with the construction of the Electronic Computer Unit, certain items of furniture and equipment were lent to I.S.I.J.U. in earlier years. This matter should be looked into.

[The project has been declared closed on 28.4.78 by the Director of ISI and Vice-Chancellor of Jadavpur University. Council's approval will be sought for adjustment of advance]

5. Account claimed/to be claimed from the Government of India : Rs. 77.53.177.80.

We have been advised that the Government has admitted claim worth Re. 39.54 lakhs. Acceptance from the Government for Rs. 37.99 lakhs included in the above claims are still awaited. Necessary adjustment for the unaccepted balance should have been made in the accounts. Further, adjustment for Rs. 4.50 lakhs (out of Rs. 39.54 lakhs) stated to have already been paid by the Government; has not been made against the optioned amount.

[The adjustment of amount of credit as arrears is awaiting to actual receipt of payment of Rs. 35.04 lakks from the Government as a special grant on arrears claims account.]

Excess of Expenditure over Receipts in respect of Miscellaneous Projects:
 Rs. 27,76,686.48

Proper steps should be taken to adjust/recover the long old outstandings of Rs. 11,69,795.18 at an early date. We have been advised that the matter is being pursued by the Accounts Department.

### [Noted]

7. Grants Receivable from Government of India: Rs. 47,000.00

This balance is being carried forward for the last few years. The Government has not admitted this claim so far. The amount should have been adjusted in the accounts.

[The amount will be duly adjusted in the next year's accounts.]

8. Stores, at cost: Re. 2,45,872.97

Physical verification of iron & steel materials of Rs. 69,703.25 (net) was not carried out during the year.

The physical verification of some of the materials showed a net loss of Rs. 2,497.23 which stands charged to Income & Expenditure Account.

The value of stock has been reduced to the extent of Rs. 29,255.91 on account of excess realisation against materials issued to contractor from stores for construction work.

It is further observed that the balance shown under "Effect of Physical verification of Building Materials Account" of Rs. 18,780.76 is lying unadjusted from earlier years. It needs an early action.

It appears that in some cases conditions of stores have deteriorated and some are unusable, the amount of which has not been ascertained nor the effect has been given in the accounts for any such loss in the value, due to deterioration and/or obsolescence.

[Physical verification of all materials except iron and steel were carried during the year. Physical verification of iron and steel will be carried on during next year.

The sum of Re. 2,497.23. charged to Income and Expenditure Account being normal in handling and processing loss.

Since value of old building materials have already been diminished, the excess amount of Bs. 29,255.91 recovered from the contractors from the issue of such materials have been credited.

The sum of Rs. 18,780.76 is normal handling and processing loss. Council's approval will be sought for writing off net amount of loss.]

### [No comment.]

- 9. Loans and Advances: Rs. 21,36,140.88
- (a) No separate Account-wise ledgers have been maintained for the following accounts:
  - (i) Relief and other loans: Rs. 3,47,425.92
  - (ii) Security deposit: Re. 1,94,754.88
  - (iii) Sundry debtors (partly recoverable): Rs. 60,605.30
  - (iv) Advance for Land: Rs. 1,21,790.38

[Account-wise ledger is being maintained in respect of (ii), (iii) & (iv) in the year 1978-79. In respect of (i) separate registers exist for flood, cereal advance etc. in a compact form and not account-wise.]

(b) Festival advance to workers: Rs. 1,13,350.00

Out of the above balance, considerable amount are outstanding since 1960-61. Amount of such old advances should have been ascertained and necessary provision should have been made to the extent these are irrecoverable.

### [Noted]

(c) Advance to suppliers and contractors : Rs. 8.11.895.62

The above balance includes a considerable amount which remained unadjusted for a long time. Such old outstandings should have been determined and adjusted before payment of fresh advances.

[Adjustment is being made to settle the old issues.]

(d) Relief (flood, drought) and other loans: Rs. 3,47,425.92

Included in the above belance are advances paid to NSSO workers, the amount of which have not been ascertained and accounted for separately.

### [Noted]

(c) Suspense and other advances: Rs. 1,38,993.49

#### INDIAN STATISTICAL INSTRUCTOR

(i) The balances of the year under audit have been reconciled. The differences prior to 1975-76 amounting to Re. 436.02 have not been reconciled.

### [Noted]

- (ii) Some of the balances are still lying unadjusted in the name of some deceased persons. No action appears to have been taken during this year also for adjusting the above balance inspite of previous Audit Report.
- (iii) It is also observed that some balances are appearing in the name of some regular employees for a long period. No steps have been taken to adjust these balances.
- [(ii), (iii) and (v), steps have been taken and some adjustments and recoveries also effected. By their very nature, settlement of these advances involve procedural delays as the amounts are in respect of deceased person or persons who have left the services of the Institute. The matter is being pursued.]
- (iv) An amount of Rs. 2,930.24 is remaining due from Dr. B. C. Das for a long time, on account of rent receivable, without any adjustment. This matter should be looked into.

### [Matter has since been taken up.]

- (v) Amount aggregating to Re. 800.99 (Cr.) are being carried forward in the name of United Bank of India, Baranagar, without any details. This Bank account was closed long time back. This matter should be enquired into.
- (vi) In the absence of particulars, amount aggregating to Rs. 1,96,220.13 credited to suspense account, could not be verified by us. Similarly, the details for Rs. 4,877.45 (debit) were also not made available to us.

### [Noted]

(vii) This account further includes unreconciled stock of materials of Rs. 10,903.00(Cr.) relating to earlier year and Rs. 10,018.75 (Dr.) for the current year. This needs proper adjustment.

### [Noted]

(viii) There are considerable amount of old unlined DR/CR balances in this account carried forward from earlier years which should have been identified and adjusted with those appearing in the Debit/Credit of some other accounts.

### [Noted]

(f) Sundry Debtors: Rs. 60,605.30

In the absence of separate ledger, the accuracy of the above balance could not be varified. This item includes old outstanding balances carried forward from as early as 1963-64. The major part of the balance is recoverable from Gun & Shell Factory (Rs. 49,721.87). No action appears to have been taken during the year under review for the recovery of the dues. Provision should be made for the unrecoverable amount.

### [Noted]

(g) Advance for land: Rs. 1,21,790.38

With regard to Bustee Land adjacent to 123, Gopal Lal Tagoro Road (Re. 12,137.00), the position remains as it was in the last year. This matter should be looked into.

### [Noted]

# 10. Additional D.A. deposited with R.P.F. Commissioner: Re. 15,48,142.62

Interest receivable on the captioned amount has not been worked out nor accounted for. Corresponding liability for the said amount of interest payable to staff/workers have also not been shown in the accounts.

[Interest on ADA deposited with Regional Provident Fund Commissioner is distributed to the workers as and when received i.e. cash basis, hence no provision for accrued interest is being made and credited to individual ledger accounts at the end of the year.]

# 11. Cash and Bank Balances:

Cash balance in hand and at Banks as shown in Schedules VI and VII attached to the Balance Shoot represent the balancing figures, i.o. individual cash and bank accounts cannot be linked up with individual fund account. The bank accounts are standing in the name of the Institute only.

Bank balances of the Institute do not include the Rupee equivalent of \$768.48 received and deposited to the Bank within the year under report. Consequently, the Bank balances do not reveal the correct position of the Institute.

[Noted. \$768.48 cheque being realised in May 1978, incorporated in the next year's account as per usage.]

# 12. Confirmatory letters:

In the absence of confirmatory letters, the balances in the following accounts could not be verified by us: (a) Claims recoverable (b) Loans & Advances (c) Departmental Imprest, and (d) Deposits and other liabilities Accounts.

### [No comment]

#### 13. General Fund:

An amount equivalent to 95% i.e. Rs. 9,85,808.57, out of the amount of Rs. 88,133.44 (Plan) and Rs. 9,49,559.79 (Non-plan) charged to Income and Expenditure Account on Books and Journals (including cost of binding etc.) has been capitalized (vide item H of Schedule I of the Institute's Balance Sheet). This has been allocated in accordance with past practice followed by the Institute.

### [No comment]

- 14. Deposits & other Liabilities:
- (a) Hospitality & Housing Committee: Rs. 1,03,708.97

In spite of observations made in previous audit reports for incorporating the accounts of the Hospitality Committee in the accounts, neither the defects have been rectified nor the credit balance have been adjusted suitably. In our opinion, immediate steps should be taken in this regard.

### (b) Library and other deposits: Rs. 3,69,630.64

The above balance represents deposits made for Library and other purposes by the members and the students as on date of the balance sheet. In course of our checking, it was found that:

(i) Periodical verification of books was not conducted during the year.

- (ii) Reconciliation of balance as per control account with those as per Library Register was not done.
- (iii) There is no record of loss of books. However, Delhi Branch carried out a physical verification of Books, after the close of the year (on 19.5.78), which revealed that 149 number of books were not traceable.
- (iv) Other Liabilities: Rs. 28.94.448.67

Provision for liability has been taken against payments made upto 30th June, 1978 for goods and services received by the Institute upto 31st March, 1978.

Included in the above amount is Rs. 14,43,037.89 as provision for gratuity during the period from 1969-70 to 1971-72. No provision for gratuity has been made during the year under report.

In course of our routine checking, it was also observed that some payments have been made in the year under audit for the expenses of the past years for which no provisions were made.

- (a) [Necessary action will be taken at the time of merger of funds as per Arrear Claims Committee Report.]
  - (b) [No comment]

[Government is reimbursing actual amount of gratuity paid during the year, hence no provision has been made.

No alternative left with us if we have to make adjustment of prior period advances.]

- 15. Observation on Different Funds
- (a) Leave Salary Fund: Dr. Rs. 1,55,555.75

Unlike other funds, this fund has got noither its own capital nor any investment. The entire debit balance represent accumulated deficit represented by the loan taken from the Institute. In our opinion, this sort of funds without any resources and corresponding investments should not continue.

(b) Electronic Data Processing & Computation Unit

Sundry Debtors: Rs. 20,745.50

With regard to above item, we could not verify the said amount in the absence of confirmatory letters from the parties concerned. No separate ledger for the parties were maintained. The above amount has been outstanding for a pretty long time. The year-wise break up are given below:

No action appears to have been taken during the year under review for recovery of the dues in spite of the fact that the matter has time and again been reported by the auditors.

### (c) Development Fund I: Rs. 1,19,521.94

The above fund remains idle prior to 1966-67. It is conserved that there is neither any transaction nor any investment in the fund. The amount of Rs. 1,19,000/- being the capital of the fund represents the amount due from the Institute as loan (Schedule IX).

[Necessary action will be taken at the time of merger of funds as per (a) to (c) Arrear Claims Committee Report.]

[Action is already being taken to invest certain loss of funds such as SQC, EDPCU etc., in short-term deposit accounts without hurting the timely requirement of funds for development and other purposes.]

### (e) Supervision Fee Fund:

- (i) No transaction appears to have taken place during the year.
- (ii) Confirmatory letter regarding credit balance standing in the name of ISI Small Scale Industries Experimental Unit of Rs. 14,910.37 was not made available for verification. Assets and liabilities of this fund have been shown in the Institute's Balance Sheet after adjusting this credit balance.

### 16. General Notes on Projects

Further to our report in para 6 above on Miscellaneous Projects we observe that the accounting activities of the different projects reveals the following facts:

- (a) In some casee agreements with outside parties for executing the projects were not abailable.
  - (b) Projects are mostly spreed over a period of at least 3 to 4 years.
  - (c) Receipt against Project expenses are reimbursed lump sum/ad hoc basis.

Since the amount recoverable on accounts of project or liability on account of payment are not accounted for in the Income and Expenditure Account, the said accounts do not reflect the correct state of affairs.

[Most of the agreements with outside parties for executing the projects were shown to the auditors. Project accounts are exhibited on cash basis, hence neither acrued income nor provision of liabilities have been made.]

### INCOME AND EXPENDITURE ACCOUNT

### 1. Travelling Expenses

Usually advances are given for travelling and debited to suspense account. Scrutiny of suspense account reveals that several advances were given for travelling expenses which remained unadjusted for a long time. Unless the accounting of such advances are made within the year of the travelling, expenses incurred are shown in the Income and Expenditure Account would not reflect the correct state of expenditure on this account.

[T.A. advances are not mixed up with suspense and shown under account code 90A. Current advances are adjusted in the same year as far as practicable.]

### 2. Reimbursement of Medical Expenses:

It was observed as in last year that actual bills against which medical advances have been made to employees are not submitted promptly for necessary adjustments. As such, medical advances remain unadjusted for a long period contrary to the rules for reimbursemen of Medical Advances.

It was also observed that the entries in the personal ledger maintained by the MERU are neither balanced periodically nor the differences between the amount claimed and the amount of actual bill adjusted.

Modical expenses include Rs. 7,936.60 representing advances paid to employees. These should have been accounted for as advances.

### [Noted]

3. Stock of Stationeries, Consumable Stores, Laboratory Stores, Tools and minor Accessories, Cost of card, cabinot otc. are neither taken at the close of the year nor accounted for. The entire purchases of these items during the year are charged in full to the Income and Expenditure Account. Physical verification report of stocks, if any, could not be produced to us for our verification.

[Impact is insignificant, since neither opening stock nor closing stock is being considered. The purchase for the year is being considered as the expenditure. Physical verification of stationery stores are conducted every year.]

### 4. Statistical Publishing Society:

Expenditure of the Society on account of electricity, telephones etc. stand debited in the accounts of Indian Statistical Institute as the expenditure of the Institute. However, a certain portion of this expenditure is realised from the Society on estimated basis.

[Electricity charges are recovered as per meter reading, telephone calls are recovered according to number of calls and proportionate hire charges in respect of accessories, rent is recovered as per agreement from SPS. Since expenditures are recovered on reimbursement basis, they are first entered in the Institute's total expenditure under those nonsuclatures.]

# 5. Farm stock at Giridih:

In the absence of any Register indicating the production, consumption and closing stock of food grains, closing stock, if any, could not be ascertained and accounted for.

### (Since been maintained)

For the purposes of Income and Expenditure Account: the allocation of expenses
between Plan and Non-plan and to different sectors (Schodule XI) as made by the officials
of the Institute have been accepted by us.

### [No comments]

### 7. General Observations:

(a) Introduction of effective internal audit system installation, in view of the fast increasing activities of the Institute, cannot be over emphasized. It was stated earlier that internal audit system was introduced in a limited way. However, no internal audit report indicating the deficiencies/short comings of the accounting system could be produced for our examination.

### [Noted]

(b) The system of budgetory control leaves ample scope for improvement. There is no means of controlling the actual expenditure within the budgeted limits because of the fact that the budget proposals as estimated by the Institute are considered as authorisation for incurring expenditure. The excess of expenditure over income has been piling up for years together due to non-observance of budget provision, claims for which are peending for acceptance by the Government for a considerable time. It is also observed that grants for specific activities/items, are diverted and or utilised to meet the excess of expenditure over income.

### [Noted]

(c) The proceedings of the Minute Book are not written on the Minute Book but are typed on separate sheets and pasted on the Minute Books.

### [It is as per usage of the Institute.]

(d) The book-keeping offers considerable scope for improvement.

We report that we have audited the Balance Sheet as at 31st March, 1978 of the Indian Statistical Institute Contributory Provident Fund, signed by us under reference to this report, and relative Income and Exponditure Account for the year ended on that date, with the books and records of the fund maintained by the Institute and produced to us and information and explanations given, and subject to the remarks mentioned below, have found them to be in accordance therewith.

The ISICPF Rules governed by Provident Fund Act, 1925 has come into force
with effect from 1st April 1975. But nowhere in the said Rules it has been stated that
ISICPF Rules will absorb the Assets & Liabilities of the Provident Fund maintained by the
Board of Trustees, ISI General Provident Fund.

The discrepancies between the General ledger balances and the balances as per members' ledger have not been reconciled this year also till the time of completion of the audit.

- (a) The Books of Account reveal that there is an opening unreconciled difference of Rs. 1,43,470.69 on account of members' own subscription, after adjustment of withdrawals. Further, no detailed lists for Rs. 4,15,348.38 were made available for our verification.
- (b) The opening difference of Rs. 2,76,397.33 in respect of Employer's contribution also await early reconciliation.

### 4. Interest Provision

- (a) Provision for interest payable to the Government on account of interest derived from realisation of G.P. Notes of Rs. 76,17,644.60 (cost price) in the year 1976, has not been made in the accounts nor ascertained; consequently, its effects on the distribution of Interest during the year on the subscriptions and contributions, could not be determined. We have been, however, advised that necessary adjustment will be made in the next year.
  - (b) Interest has also not been provided for on the balances lying in Dead Accounts.
  - 5. Loan to members: Rs. 24,94,394.36

In course of our examination of the records, the following irregularities were observed:

- (a) In some cases, deductions for recovery of loans were not made in equal monthly instalments.
- (b) The house/sites purchased by members out of withdrawals from the fund have not been supported by assignment of deed in favour of the trustees as required under the Rules,

#### 6. Relief Loan to Members: Rs. 41,936.00

This represents amount recoverable from ISI and NSSO workers. Detailed lists in support of the above balance were not submitted for our verification. During the year under review, a very small sum aggregating to Rs. 406.00 only was realised.

#### 7. Income Tax Recoverable: Rs. 18,570.00

This amount is being carried forward for over two years. Steps should be taken to realise the amount as early as possible.

- 9. Non-compliance of C.P.F. Rules
- (a) The provision of Rule 8 (a) of the C.P.F. Rules regarding monthly contribution by the employer have not been followed during the year under review. However, we observed that same are being complied with from the subsequent year.
- (b) Contrary to Rule 10(a) of the C.P.F. Rules, amount exceeding Rs. 20,000/- had been kept with Banks. As on 31st March 1978, the balance as per books was Rs. 17,97,511.68 including a cheque for Rs. 8,43,610.35 deposited after the close of the year. Non-investment of such excess fund at appropriate time resulted in a considerable loss of interest. This matter needs immediate attention of the Trustees of the Fund.
- 10. We did not have produced for our verification confirmatory letters from the Government of India for Rs. 10,55,303.26 on account of difference in the rate of interest payable to N.S.S.O. workers and for Rs. 31,82,124 payable to N.S.S.O. workers.
