AUDITORS' REPORT

We report that we have audited the Balance Sheets as at 31st March, 1979 signed by na under reference to this report, of

- (a) Indian Statistical Institute and
- (b) Other Funds

and the annexed Income and Expenditure Accounts for the year ended on that date with the books and records maintained by the Institute and produced to us and information and explanations given and, subject to and read with the notes appearing thereon and also subject to the remarks given below, have found them to be in accordance therewith.

The remarks referred to above are:

1. Though National Sample Survey Unit has been separated from the Institute with effect from lat June 1972, the consequential changes with regard to Assets and Liabilities taken over by them, have not taken place in the accounts as yet. As such, the Balance Sheet as at 31st March 1979 of the Indian Statistical Institute and the Income and Expenditure Account for the year ended on that date do not give true and fair view to the extent of this unworked-out position.

[The problem arising out of discrepancies in the list of field assets transferred to N880 at the time of separation from ISI and certified its rubmitted by N880 authorities in the year 1978 has been reported at the time of consideration of accounts in the last year. No decision regarding adjustment of these discrepancies has been taken yet.]

2. Pixed Assels:

(a) Assets Register for Land/Land Development were not maintained in proper form indicating the broak up of the constituent expenses in connection with the same. In some cases the value as por Register do not agree with the value as shown by the General Ledger.

Registers for fixed assets are being maintained showing inter-alia, the written down value of the assets as on 31st March 1976 as the original cost of Assets.

[Land and Land Development Register has been maintained in a separate register oscending to the Proforms suggested by the auditors. We are now incorporating the particulars in our fixed assets register with retrospective effect from 1976-77.]

(i) Value of fixed assets acquired on dates prior to 31st March 1952 were taken from those appearing in the inventories prepared as on that date.

(This is just meant for information.)

(ii) No physical vorification of Fixed Assets were carried out during the year under audit.

Italicised portion in brackets are the comments of the Administration on the observations made by

[Committee at up for this purpose yet to submit a report.]

(iii) An appropriate committee and up to make a detailed report regarding the obsolete/discarded assets, for taking appropriate written off action, submitted a report long time back on which no action has been taken as yet.

[Report of the Committee was submitted to the Council and the Council has wanted some further details. The details will be submitted to the Council for appropriate action.]

- (b) Land: Tible deeds in respect of the following Lands possessed by the Institute were not available for our verification:
- (1) 156, 160, 165 & 166/J, Gopal Lai Tagoro Road (II) 205 B. T. Road, (III) 206 B. T. Road, (IV) Dolhi, (V) Farm Land, Giridih, (VI) Bangaloro, (VII) In Villago Makatpur, Giridih, (VIII) 153 Gepal Lai Tagoro Road, (IX) 203 B. T. Road, (X) 202 B. T. Road, (XI) Land at Giridih from Smt. Prakriti Dobi, (XII) Madraa.

Possession cartificates and/or grant certificates for items (I) to (VIII) were produced before us for our varification. In respect of item (IX) certified copy of the plan showing the area was produced. With regard to item (X), the Dood of Transfer was produced. In respect of item (X1) certified copy of the Salo Deed was made available to us. No document in respect of item (X11) certified copy of the Salo Deed was made available to us.

[This is just meant for information.]

(c) Library Building at Baranagar: Rs. 88.57.772.73

The building is in progress. The records to the extent produced to us, reveal that the construction of the building could not be completed within the stipulated time. The need for imposition of "liquidated damage" clause for non-completion of the same within the stipulated period, if applicable, should be considered at the time of final payment.

[Noted]

(d) Buildings at New Delhi : Rs. 51,80,768.74

The quantity of Coment issued to Contractors has not been linked up with the quantity deducted from their bills. Consequently, the possibility of under/over deduction from the Contractors' bills cannot be ruled out.

[Delhi office has been asked to reconcile.]

(e) Laboratory equipment: Rs. 10,49,257.26

Included under "Additions during the year" is Rs. 1,45,436.34 representing estimated value of Equipments received by the Institute on the clearer of the ISIJU Project. No depreciation has been charged on this amount.

[Depreciation has not been charged as per usage.]

(f) Soviet Printing Machines: Rs. 5,08,657.13

Soviet Printing Machines are being utilized by the Statistical Publishing Society. It was given by the Soviet Academy of Sciences as a gift to the Institute. The amount of

Rs. 18,66,696.58 was taken as the value of the machines in the books of accounts and corresponding credit was made to the General Fund Account in 1970-71. We are advised that few items of the machines are damaged and there are some items which are not being utilised for various reasons.

- [This is just meant for information.]
- (g) Electronic Computer at Baranagar: Rs. 41,94,217.69

The above expenditure does not include the installation and other relative expenses to be borne by the linstitute as por agreement with the Electronic Trade & Technology Development Corporation Ltd. The amount of such expenses should have been ascertained and accounted for. The value of a generator of Rs. 3,15,107.36 is included in the above expenditure.

- [Cost of machines includes installation charges. Free fooding and lodging charges of 11 Russian Engineers provided by the Institute, charged to Revenue Account.]
 - (h) Books and Journals: Rs. 65.33.215.14.
 - (i) A sum of Rs. 1,37,369.84 was expended for purchase of Books and Journals by the Bangalore branch. Proper documentary evidences as to the value of the Books and receipt of the same were not made available for our audit.

[It is ascertained from the Head, Bangalore Centre that all books and journals whatever purchased users entered in one accession register which could not be sent to Baranagar for risk of loss of link of receipts and issues of books and journals during the transit period. However, confirmation letter of cutry in accession register was shown to auditors.]

- (ii) In course of our checking it was found that :
- (a) Periodical verification of books was not conducted during the year except in Delhi.
- (b) Reconciliation of balance as per control account with those as per Library Register (where maintained) was not done.
 - [Verification has just been completed. A report is expected to be submitted soon.]
 - (i) Laboratory & other Equipments:

Additions to Laboratory Equipment, Office equipment, Electrical Equipments and Calculating, Punching and tabulating equipments include Rs. 10,203.53, Rs. 2,821.72, Rs. 11,788.39 and Rs. 6,474.72 respectively being adjustment of advances which are not supported by proper invoices.

[These pertain to purchases made long back and kept in advance and now adjusted on the strength of challan and accession records.]

3. Investments:

Investment of different funds under the Institute (excepting ISICPF) stand in the name of the Indian Statistical Institute. Securities our-marked for the specific funds have been disclosed in the respective fund balance sheet.

[This is just meant for information.]

4. Advance on account of ISIJU Expenditure on joint project:

This project has since been declared closed. The not amount of loss of Rs. 6,24,738.34 introd by the Institute on this project has been written off this year to the debit of General Fund.

[This is just meant for information.]

5. Amount claimed/to be claimed from the Government of India: Re. 77,53,177.80

We have been advised that the Government has admitted claims worth Rs. 39.54 lakhs. Acceptance from the Government for the balance amount of Rs. 37.99 lakhs included in the above claims are still awaited. Necessary provision for the unaccepted balance of claims should have been made in the accounts. Further, we were not shown any record indicating the adjustment made for Rs. 4.50 lakhs (out of Rs. 39.54 lakhs) stated to have already been paid by the Government.

[Adjustment in this matter is kept in abeyance pending Council decision.]

 Excess of Expenditure over Receipts in respect of Miscellaneous Projects: Rs. 29.90.505.10

Proper stops should be taken to adjust/recover the long old outstandings of Rs. 15,91,415.53 at an early date. We have been advised that the matter is being pursued by the Institute.

[We are making rigorous efforts to recover further amount. Amount recovered within the year is Rs. 3,16,896.85 and Rs. 6.00 lakhs in 1979-80.]

7. Stores, at cost: Rs. 3,44,287.80

The physical verification of some of the materials showed a not loss of Re. 1,124.41 which stands charged to Income and Expenditure Account.

It is further observed that the balance shown under "Effect of physical verification of Building Materials Account" of Rs. 18,780.76 is lying unadjusted from earlier years. It needs an early action.

It appears that in some cases conditions of Stores have deteriorated and/or are unusable, the amount of which has not been ascertained. No effect has been given in the accounts for any loss in the value of stores due to such deterioration and/or obsolescence, if any

[The sum of Rs. 1,124.41 charged to income and expenditure account being normal handling and processing loss.

The matter was placed before the Council and after discussion it was decided that works Advisory Committee is to examine and make recommendation. Appropriate action soil be taken after Works Advisory Committee consider the matter.

Concerned department has been advised to ascertain deterioration in quality of materials, if any. However, whenever any material is condemned as unusuable due effect is given in the accounts. 1

- 8. Loans and Advances: Rs. 31.93.595.65
- (a) No separate Account-wise ledgers for the following amount were made available for our examination:
 - (i) Relief, House Building and other loans : Rs. 8.55,936.70
 - (ii) Security deposit: Rs. 1,33,551.26
 - (iii) Sundry dobtors (Partly recoverable): Rs. 60,605.30
 - (ip) Fostival advance to workers: Rs. 1,25,205,00
 - (v) Travelling advance: Re. 1,65,469.35

[Accountwise ledgers maintained by us could not be examined by auditors since the original records confirmation letters are not readily available.]

(h) Festival Advance to workers: Rs. 1.25,205.00

No dotails were made available to us in support of the above advances. Out of the above balances, some amount are outstanding since 1980-61. Amount of such old advances should have been ascertained and necessary provision should have been made to the extent these are irrecoverable.

- (Out of Rs. 1,25,205.00 festival advance less than one year amounts to Rs. 1,05,000/and balance outstanding since 1960.61 amounts to Rs. 15.38 paise.
 - (c) Advance to suppliers and contractors: Ra. 11,08,778.59
- [Out of Rs. 11,68,778.59 advance less than one year amounts to Rs. 8,09,831.94 and more than 5 years Rs. 52,331.13.]
 - (d) Suspense and other advances Rs. 1,94,150.70
 - (i) The amount of old outstandings included under item (c) above should have been determined and adjusted before payment of fresh advances.
- (We are acting on the same direction as auditors suggested except where materials received or services rendered but final bill is not available, second advance is made.)
 - (ii) A sum of Rs. 32,213.56 was paid, to a supplior of coment, by Dolhi branch in the year 1975.76 for purchase of coment. The supplier neither supplied coment till date nor refunded the money. Necessary provision for the amount should have been made in the accounts.
 - [Civil suit has been filed by our Delhi Branch to recover the amount.]
 - (iii) The balances of the year as per suspense ledger have been reconciled with the main ledger. The differences prior to 1976-76 amounting to Ra. 716.71 have not been reconciled.

[Noted]

(iv) Included under suspense account are old balances aggregating to Rs. 1,43,172.22 (not) which are still lying unadjusted in the name of some deceased persons, some visiting professors, regular employees of the Institute and others. Steps should be taken for adjusting the said old outstandings.

[The work is in progress. Some adjustments made and recoveries also affected during the year. The matter is being pursued.]

(v) An amount of Rs. 2,930.24 is remaining due from Dr. B. C. Das for a long time, on account of rent receivable, without any adjustment. This matter should be looked into.

[The matter is looked into.]

(vi) Amount aggregating to Rs. 800.99 (cr.) are being carried forward in the name of United Bank of India, Baranagar without any details. This Bank A/c. was closed long time back. This matter should be enquired into.

[Despite of our persuation, no further details are available. It will be adjusted in due course.]

(vii) In the absonce of particulars, amount aggregating to Re. 1,23,763.70 oredited to suspense account, could not be verified by us. Similarly, the details for Rs. 60,353.43 (dobit) were also not made available to us.

[The matter is looked into.]

(viii) This account further includes adjustments for unreconciled stock of different kind of materials of Rs. 5,564.08 (Not Cr.). This needs proper adjustment.

[After thorough scrutiny, we have adjusted Rs. 8,458.82 in the ourrent year, balance on detection will be adjusted shortly.]

(iz) There are considerable amount of old unlinked debit/credit balances in the above accounts carried forward from earlier years which should have been identified and adjusted with those appearing in the Debit/Credit of some other accounts.

[Noted]

(e) Rollef (Flood, Drought) House Building and other loans-Rs. 8,55,938.70

Included in the above balance are advances paid to NSSO workers, the amount of which have not been ascertained and accounted for separately.

[As advised by the auditors we shall show the dues of NSSO workers separately henceforth.]

(f) Sundry Dobtors; Rs. 60,605.30

In the absence of separate ledger, the accuracy of the above balance could not be verified. This item includes old outstanding balances carried forward from as early as 1963-64. The major part of the balance is recoverable from Gun & Shell Factory (Rs. 49,721.87). No effort appears to have been made during the year under review for the recovery of the dues. Provision should be made for the unrecoverable amount.

9. Additional D.A. deposited with R.P.F. Commissioner: Rs. 4,82,710.65

Interest receivable on the captioned amount and payable to workers has not been with the dutt nor accounted for. The difference of Re. 4,868.65 (Cr.) between the amount payable to staff/workers and the amount receivable from Regional Provident Fund Commissioner awaits reconsilisation.

[Interest is dealt on cosh bosis. Difference amount located could not be deposited with Regional Provident Fund Commissioner by virtue of notification of the Central Commissioner, Provident Fund dated 10.5.77.1

- 10. Cash & Bank Balances:
- (a) Cash balance in hand and at Banks as abown in the Schedule VI and VII attached to the Balance Sheet indicates the balancing figures, as the individual cash and bank balances are not maintained separately for individual fund account. The bank account are standing in the name of the Institute only. The cash statements of Bangalore (DRTC) branch indicated that there were minus cash balances on two occasions. This matter should be enquired into.
 - [It is meant for information only.

Bangalore (DRTC) has been advised to have monthly cash verification to avoid such situation in future.]

(b) Bank balances: In the absence of Reconciliation statement and/or confirmatory letters, the following balances could not be verified.

Hyderabad Unit (No reconciliation) Rs. 38,382.40

Reserve Bank of India Rs. 67,008.80

Nath Bank Ltd. (In liquidation) Ra. 3,812.57

[State Bank of India certificate showing balance as on 31.3.79 for Hyderabad Branch has been submitted to the Auditors. Reconciliation statement has been asked from the Branch. Certificate of Nath Bank Ltd. (in liquidation) was not available although we wrote two letters. The Pass Book of Reserve Bank of India P[L A]c. was produced to Auditors. R.B.I. does not issue balance confirmation certificate.]

11. General Fund:

An amount equivalent to 95%, Rs. 14,39,303.24 out of the amount of Rs. 3,26,310.22 (Plan) and Rs. 11,88,745.82 (Non-plan) charged to Income and Expenditure Account on Books and Journals (including cost of binding etc.) has been capitalized. This has been allocated in accordance with peat practice followed by the Institute.

[This is just meant for information.]

- 12. Deposits and other Liabilities:
 - (a) Hospitality & Housing Committee: Rs. 1,03,651.93

In spite of observations made in previous sudit reports for incorporating the accounts of the Haspitality Committee in the accounts, notifier the defects have been rectified nor the credit balance have been adjusted suitably. In our opinion, immediate steps should be taken in this regard.

- [Necessary action will be taken at the time of merger of funds as per Arrear Claims Committee Report.]
 - (b) Staff Income Tax and Annuity Deposit: Ra. 55,952.51

The amount of Tax to be deposited as per General Ledger and the amount of Tax deposited as per Annual Return do not agree. This should have been reconciled.

[The amount cannot agree. The balance amount of staff income tax for the year 1977-78 was deposited in the month of April 1978 and for the year 1978-79 deposited on 29.4.79 which is permissible by income tax rules.]

(a) Other Liabilities : Rs. 47,62,899.20

Provision for liability has been taken against payments made upto 30th June, 1979 for goods and services received by the Institute relating to the year ended on 31st March 1979.

Included in the above amount is Rs. 14,43,037.89 as provision for gratuity relating to the period from 1969-70 to 1971-72.

In course of our checking it was also observed that some payments have been made in the year under audit for the expenses of the past years for which no provisions were made.

[This is just meant for information.]

- 13. Observations on Different Funds
 - (a) Leave Salary Funds: Dr. Rs. 1,55,555.75

Unlike other funds, this fund has got neither its own capital nor any investment. The entire debit balance represents accumulated deficit represented by the lean taken from the Institute. In our opinion, this sort of funds without any resources and corresponding investments should not continue.

(b) Electronic Data Processing & Computation Unit

Sundry Dobtors: Rs. 20,745.50

With regard to above item, we could not verify the said amount in the absence of confirmatory lotters from the parties concorned. No separate lodger for the parties were maintained. The above amount has been outstanding for a pretty long time. The year-wise break up are given below:

No action appears to have been taken during the year under review for recovery of the dues in spite of the fact that the matter has time and again been reported by the auditors.

- It is observed that a sum of Rs. 9,000]- due from the Institute has not been realised and invested in outside securities.
- [Necessary action will be taken at the time of merger of funds as per Arrear Claims Committee Report].

- (d) Others:

- (ii) Confirmatory letter regarding credit balance standing in the name of ISI Small Scale Industries Experimental Unit of Rs. 14,810.37 was not made available for verification. Assets and Liabilities of this fund have been shown in the Institute's Balance Sheet after adjusting this credit balance.
- [Necessary action will be taken of the time of merger of funds as per Arrear Claims Committee Report].
- 14. We observed in course of our checking that interest has not been collected for a long period on investments in respect of Development Fund II and Director's Contribution Fund.
 - [Action has been taken recently for collection of the amount.]
 - 15. General Notes on Projects

Further to our report in para 6 above on Miscellaneous Projects, we observe that the accounting activities of the different projects reveal the following facts:

- (a) In some cases agreements with outside parties for executing the projects were not available.
 - (b) Projects are mostly spread over a period of at least 3 to 4 years.
 - (c) Receipt against Project expenses are reimbursed lump sum/ad hoe basis.

Since the amount recoverable on account of project or liability, on account of payment, are not accounted for in the Income and Expenditue Account, the said accounts do not reflect the correct state of affairs.

- (Project accounts are exhibited on cash basis hence neither accrued income nor provision of liabilities have been made.)
- 16. In the absence of confirmatory letters, the balance in the following accounts remained unverified: (a) Claims recoverable (b) Loans and Advances (c) Dues from Regional Provident Fund Commissioner and (d) Deposit and other liabilities.
 - [This is just meant for information,]

INCOME AND EXPENDITURE ACCOUNT

1. Travelling Expenses :

Advances, usually given for travelling, are debited to suspense account. Scrutiny of suspense account roveals that several advances were given for travelling expenses which remained unadjusted for a long time. Unless the accounting of such advances are made within the year of the expenditure incurred, the Income and Expenditure Account would not reflect the correct state of expenditure on this account.

A sum of 30,000 Yons was recoverable from a Professor against his travelling bill for Japan tour. This sum has not yet been realised.

[T.A. advances are not mixed up with suspense. They are shown under account one, 90d instead of account code No. 900. Current advances are adjusted in the same year if journey is completed within the year. Recovery has started from concerned executive in respect of 33,000 Yeas due from him.]

2. Leave Travel Concession :

Unlike provious years, the amount of LTC advances to the extent not supported by travelling bills, have been shown as advances. Due to this change in the accounting procedure current year's exponditure stands under-stated to the extent of Rs. 1,42,096.25 Further, details for Rs. 4,668.23 (advances of Dolhi Unit) were not made available for our audit.

[Advances paid booked as expenditure in the past only in the case of LTO, which does not reflect correct picture of LTO expenses, hence the same is segregated and shown separately. Delhi office has been asked to furnish the delails to LTO advance.

3. Reimbursement of Medical Expenses:

There is a difference of Rs. 17,212.27 between the balances as per General Ledger and the records of MERU.

It was observed, as in last year, that actual bills against which medical advances have been made to employees are not submitted promptly for necessary adjustments. As such, medical advances remain unadjusted for a long period centrary to the rules for reimbursement of Medical Advances.

It was also observed that the entries in the personal ledger maintained by the MERU are neither balanced periodically nor the differences, between the amount claimed and the amount of actual bill, adjusted.

Modical expenses include Rs. 6,344.67 representing advances paid to employees. These should have been accounted for as advances.

[Sleps taken to reconcile the difference amount.]

4. Machine Tabulation Expenses:

Includes Rs. 10,840.00 representing 1/3rd value of the tabulating machines purchased from IBM World Trade Corporation in 1977-78 at a cost of Rs. 31,920.10. The antire value should have been capitalised.

- [Necessary effect will be given in the books of account of the Institute during the year 1979-80 as suggested by the Auditors.]
- 5. Stock of Stationories, Consumable Stores, Laboratory Stores, Tools and minor Accessories, Cost of Card, Cabinet dot, are neither taken at the close of the year nor accounted for. The entire purchases of those items during the year are charged in full to the Income and Expenditure Account. Physical verification report of stocks of above Items, if any, could not be produced to us for our verification.
- [Impact is insignificant, since neither opening stock nor closing stock is being considered.
 The purchase for the year is being considered as the expenditure. Physical verification of stationery and stores is conducted every year.]
 - 6. Receipts SQC: Ra. 10,30,388.34

The Bangalore Centre received Rs. 1,11,947.34 in respect of the above, for which no bills were made available for our examination.

[Bangalore SQC Unit has been advised to send the copies of bills.]

7. Rent:

We understand that the Rose Villa-Giridih, owned by the Institute is under cooupation of NSSO. Rent if any, has not been realised from the said Organisation, so far.

[This is just meant for information.]

- 8. Statistical Publishing Society:
- Exponditure of the Society on account of electricity, telephones etc. stand debited in the accounts of Indian Statistical Institute as the expenditure of the Institute. However, a certain portion of this expenditure is realised from the Society on estimated basis.
- [Blectricity charges are recovered as per meter reading, telephone calls according to number of calls and rent is recovered as per agreement with SPS. Since expenditure are recovered on reinhursement basis they are first entereed in the Institute's total expenditure under those nomen-clatures. \[\]
 - 9. Farm stock at Giridih:
- In the absence of any Register indicating the production, consumption and closing stock of food grains, closing stock, if any, could not be ascertained and accounted for.
- [The register was incomplete at the time of auditors' inspection of Giridih Branch. However, this will not be repeated in future. \
- 10. For the purpose of Income and Expenditure Account, the allocations of expenses between Plan and Non-plan and to different sectors (Schedule XI) as made by the officials of the Institute have been accepted by us.

[This is just meant for information.]

- 11. General Observations:
- (a) Introduction of offective internal audit system in view of the fast increasing activities of the Institute, is of imperative need. Steps should be taken to implement the system as early as possible.

[The recommendation is being looked into.]

- (b) The system of budgetory control leaves sample scope for improvement. There is no means of controlling the actual expanditure within the budgeted limits because of the fact that the budget proposals as estimated by the Institute are considered as authorisation for incurring expenditure. The excess of expenditure over income has been piling up for years together due to non-observance of budget provision, claims for which are pending for acceptance by Government for a considerable time. It is also observed that grants for specific activities are divirted and/or utilized to meet the excess of expenditure over income.
 - (0) The book-keeping offers comiderable scope for improvement.

Approved by the Council and General Body

The sudited statement of accounts, together with the Auditor's Report and the comments of the Administration, were discussed in detail by the Finance Committee in its meeting on 9 January, 1980.

The Finance Committee recommended adoption of the audited statement of accounts for the year 1978-1979 and the Auditors' Report with the following observations:

- (1) There are several comments in the Auditors' Report regarding the funds of the Institute. It has been reported that the Institute is not in a position to settle the matter in view of the fact that the Council has not taken a final decision regarding the Report of the Arrear Claims Committee. The Finance Committee recommends that a decision regarding the Arrear Claims Committee Report be taken expeditiously by the Council, so that appropriate adjustments may be made in the books of accounts of the Institute.
- (2) Regarding the Auditors' comment in para 6 of the Auditors' Report on recovery of outstanding dues in "Excess of expenditure over receipts in miscellaneous projects Accounts", the Committee noted that a large portion of the dues was to be recovered from government sources as follows:—
 - (a) ISEC Colombo Plan Followship ... Rs. 9,42,658
 - (b) Ministry of Hoalth and Family Welfare for projects ... Rs. 12,14,775
 - (c) Ministry of Planning-NSSO Ra. 8,42,525

The Committee was informed that during the year 1970-1980, a num of Ra. 6 lakha had already been received from the Ministry of Health and Family Wolfare, and the Ministry had promised that the remaining portion of dues would be settled after submission of the audited statement of accounts for the year 1978-79.

Regarding other dues, the Committee was informed that steps had been taken by Administration for settlement of outstanding dues.

- (3) The system for maintenance of suspense account and for adjustment of the suspense account must be streamlined so as to avoid audit comments on the same.
- (4) The Committee was informed that there had been specific instructions to the Institute to keep the balance amount in the scholarship fund in the Reserve Bank of India. The Committee noted that for an amount of more than Ra. 67,000 kept in the Reserve Bank of India, no interest was being paid. The Committee wanted that the matter should be taken up with the Covernment so that the earlier instructions might be reviewed.
- (5) The Committee was told that a sum of about Rs. 6-5 lakks belonging to different funds as reported by the Auditors under para 13(d)(1) had been invested by the Institute during the year 1979-1980.
- (6) On Auditors' comments regarding re-imbursement of medical expenses, the Committee felt that the procedure of accounting in the Medical Reimbursement Unit could be simplified.

- (7) The Committee was informed that physical verification of stationeries and consumable stores was being taken up once in a year. The Committee recommends that such physical verification should start after the close of the financial year but before the commencement of audit for the same year.
- (8) The Committee noted that a register showing production, consumption and closing stock of foodgrains was being maintained in Giridih. The Committee, however, felt that a correct picture, explaining the reasons as to why the Auditors could not be given the details, should have been given in the Administrative reply more clearly.
- (9) The Committee noted the Auditors' remark regarding the introduction of an effective internal audit system in the Institute and recommended that steps must be taken to organise such a system immediately.

(10) Regarding the Auditors' remark on the budgetary control system in the Institute under pars 11(b) on 'Income and Expenditure Accounts', the Committee found that the facts pertaining to the year 1974-79 did not, however, indicate any slackness in the budget control measures in the Institute, as is orident from the following figures:

AUDITORS' REPORT

We report that we have audited the Balance Sheet as at 31st March, 1979 of the Indian Statistical Institute Contributory Provident Fund, signed by us under reference to this report, and relative Income and Expenditure Account for the year ended on that date, with the books and records of the fund maintained by the Institute and produced to us and information and explanations given, and subject to the remarks mentioned below, have found them to be in accordance therewith.

 1. Members' own subscription
 Rs. 54,13,467-99

 Employer's Contribution
 Rs. 68,22,805-95

 Members' Yoluntary subscription
 Rs. 2,79,406-75

The discrepancies between the General ledger balances and the balances as per members' ledger have not been reconciled this year also till the time of completion of the audit.

2. Interest payable on:

(a) Members' own subscription Rs. 26,03,076-64
(b) Employer's contribution Rs. 30,00,604-76

(c) Additional Dearness Allowance due to workers

Ra. 67,810-63

- (a) With regard to Members' own subscription, the Books of Account reveal that there was an opening unreconciled difference of Rs. 2,70,782-91, after adjustment of withdrawals. This difference has been brought down to Rs. 8,333-94 by passing an entry for Rs. 2,62,448-97 based on estimation.
- (b) As regards interest payable on Employer's contribution, the opening balance as per General Lodger was short by Rs. 2,77,895-56 as against the balance indicated by Members' ledger. With a view to reconcile this difference an entry for Rs. 2,82,477-49 has been passed on estimated basis.
- (c) In case of Additional Dearness allowance to workers, there is also an unreconciled opening difference of Ra. 899.75.

Satisfactory explanations for passing entires on estimated basis under item (a) and (b) above were not forthcoming. As a result of such adjustments, the Income of the Provident Fund for the year under report stands reduced to the extent of Rs. 20,028-52. Effort should be made to reconcile all the aforesaid differences based on facts and duly supported by individual members' balances.

- 3. Interest Provision:
- (a) As stated in our last report, provision for interest payable to the Government on account of interest derived from realisation of 0.P. Notes of Rs. 76,17,844-60 (cost price) in the year 1976, has not been made this year also nor the amount ascertained; consequently, its affects on the distribution of Interest during the year on the subscriptions and contribution, could not be determined.

- (b) Interest has not been provided for on the balances lying in Deed Accounts nor on the opening balances of Re. 31,82,124-42 payable to NSSO workers, where applicable, on account of delayed payment.
 - 4. Loan to members-Rs. 18,12,158-45

In course of our examination of the records, the following irregularities were observed :

- (a) In a few cases, marriage losss were paid to workers in contravention of Rule 19(b) (2) of ISICPF Rules.
- (b) Deductions for recovery of loans were not made in all cases in equal monthly instalments.
- (e) In some cases, Interest on lean to members were also not deducted every month as per Rule 19(f)(IV) of the Provident Fund Rules.
- (d) The balances extracted from Mombers' ledger were not tallied with the General Ledger balance.
- (e) Loan to Members also include loan to NSSO Workers, the correct amount of which has not been ascertained and segregated.
 - 5. Relief Loan to Members-Rs. 41,869-00
- This represents amount recoverable from ISI and NSSO workers. Detailed lists in support of the above balance were not submitted for our verification. During the year under review, a very small sum agregating to Rs. 67-00 only was realised.
 - 6. Income Tax Recoverable-Rs. 18.570-00

This amount is being carried forward for over three years. Steps should be taken to realise the amount as early as possible.

- 7. (a) We did not have produced for our verification, confirmatory letters from the Government of India for Ra. 10,55,303-26 on account of difference in the rate of interest payable to NSSO workers and for Ra. 17.30.472-36 payable to NSSO workers.
- (b) Confirmatory letter for Rs. 3,61,950-34 payable to the Institute, was also not available.
 - 8. Book Keeping offers soope for improvement.
