Replacement of old poof tiles of Guest House at Giridih was carried out.

Hostels

The initial plans submitted by the consultant was scrutinised in detail by the B.W.A.C. and it was felt that certain modifications should have to be incorporated before finalisation of the plans. Two hostels - a Boys' Hostel of capacity 136 and a Ladies Hostel of capacity 56 have been planned. An existing old building at the proposed site for the Ladies Hostel has been demolished. It is expected that finalisation of building plans and submission of drawings to the local municipality for approval could be done soon.

Miscellaneous Constructions

Various renovation/repair/facelifting works at the office buildings, residential Quarters, Hostels etc. were carried out during the current year. The allocated fund of Rs.10.46 lakhs totally used up in these various works at the different premises of the Institute.

Delhi

The work of construction of the Administrative Block of ISI Delhi Centre was entrusted to CPWD against an estimated sanction of Rs.47.52 lakkhs in March 1997. The CPWD started construction in February 1998 and completed the building by the end of August 1999. Thereafter, the interior partitioning and furnishing work etc. were taken up departmentally. The ground floor houses administration and accounts department and the first floor consists of two seminar rooms and one conference hall. The New Administrative Block has been functioning from November 1999 after its inauguration by the Director of ISI.
