Central Stores Unit: All stationery and articles including furniture required for use in various divisions of the Institute are procured through Central Stores Unit. They also procure and store materials required for day to day maintenance of building, and for the water and power supplies. A small Tailoring Unit is although to it.

Security Unit: Security Unit is entrusted with the important task of maintaining security of the vast campus of the Institute and its properties.

Telephone Unit: The EPABX Unit has three electronic telephone exchanges installed by Crompton Greaves Ltd. in the Institute's Campus at Calcutta. The main exchange (NE-1100) is housed at 202. B.T. Road and two other small exchanges (NE-20M and NE-30) are located at 205. B.T. Road campus These three exchanges are interconnected. The main exchange (NE-1100) and a small exchange (NE-30) are manned by Telephone Operators during working hours and work in automatic mode after office hours and holidays (in night-mode connection) at different units as per instruction. The NE-20M exchange operates in the automatic mode.

Transport Unit: Besides a fleet of vehicles, the Institute has four buses and an ambulance. The vehicles are for use by the visiting scientists and dignitaries and by the workers in carrying out the activities of the Institute. The buses are used for transporting workers from eastern and southern part of Kolkata and its suburbs. The ambulance is used to carry ailing workers or members of their families to and from hospital for emergency treatment on recommendation of the doctors attached to Medical Welfare Unit. The Transport Unit looks affer the use and maintenance of the vehicles.

Guest House: The New Guest House of the Institute has started functioning from December 1997. It has 6 A/c suits, 8 A/C single rooms, 6 Non-A/C double rooms, and 21 Non-A/C single rooms. There is also an A/C VIP lounge, a nicely decorated conference room with a modern public address system and overhead projector on the 1st Floor of the Guest House and an A/C dining hall on the ground floor of the Guest House. All the rooms are well furnished with 24 hrs. telephone facilities/Internet facilities are available.

Besides the Institute guests and visitors, scientists and representatives from Institutes/Organisations like NSSO, NIOH, SSI, Rabindra Bharati University, Calcutta University etc. are being provided Guest House facilities on payment. Guest House service during the year 2000-2001 went on in full swing.

Apart from the Units mentioned above, there are some small cells dealing with Budget, Import, Travel and House Building Advances etc. to take care of the specific needs of the Institute. The Administrative Services Division also looks after the running of hostels for students, research scholars and International Statistical Education Centre (ISEC) trainees and also the running of Canteen for the workers and students of the Institute. The other outlying Units numbering eight are controlled directly by the headquarters at Kolkata. The Administrative Services Division takes the responsibility for all new construction activities of the Institute at its headquarters and also at outlying centres/branches. A brief report on the construction activity in the current year is given later.

The activities of the Administrative Services in the two Centres, namely Delhi and Bangalore, and in other outlying branches of the Institute are more or less the same but on a much smaller scale. Depending on the needs of the branches/centres the units have been truncated and merged into fewer units.

Staff of the Institute

The Government of India agreed that ISI might continue with the staff strength, the various posts, scales of pay, promotional policies and other service conditions as were existing in the past before imposing embargo. They also allowed revision of the payscales as approved by the Council for all categories including entegories of posts for non faculty workers where certain anomalies existed. As a result of the clearance from the Government, the Institute has undertaken measures to recruit workers in various categories where there are

Budget and Finance

For the year 2000-2001 the Institute's budget was estimated to be Rs.3770.60 lakhs and Rs.1391.25 lakhs towards Non-Plan and Plan respectively at the BE stage. The Govt. after considering the report of the Section 8(1) Committee approved a sum of Rs.3561.50 lakhs including internal receipts and Rs.1171.00 lakhs for Non-Plan and Plan expenditure respectively. At the revised estimates stage, the Institute sought for a grant of Rs.4025.85 lakhs and Rs.1171.00 lakhs in Non-Plan and Plan estimates respectively. The Government approved a sum of Rs.3761.10 lakhs on Non-Plan, the Plan RE allocation was fixed at Rs.1171.01 lakhs. The expenditure during the year under report was well within the budget allocation sanctioned by the Government. The Audited Annual Accounts of the Institute for the year 2000-2001 have been furnished in part IV of this report.

Land and Construction

The following major activities were undertaken by the Institute during 2000-2001.

Kolkata

A-type quarter

Construction work was completed in November 2000. The final bill value of the Contractor was 8x64.184 lakhs. Work of internal electrification and external electrification work for the building were also completed during the year through separate tenders.

Canteen Building (Phase -I)

Construction of first phase work continued in full swing and structural works and a substantial pan of finishing works have been completed. The Contractor, M/S. DMP Nirman Private Ltd., was paid a bill amount of Rs. S8. 31 lakhs and the Consultant, M/S. DCL was paid Consultancy charges of Rs. 0.97 lakhs.

Bank and Post-Office Building (Phase - 1)

Civil, Sanitary and Plumbing Works for the building was completed in December 2000 against final bill value of Rs.37 lakhs. Internal electrification works for the building was also completed during the year at a cost of Rs.251 lakhs.

Renovation of Old Buildings (Phase - I)

Renovation of roof of RTS building and major portion of repair/renovation of Geology building have been completed during the year.

Academic Building (one block)

The Piling (Foundation) work for the building was awarded to M/S. DMP Nirman Private Ltd. against work order value of Rs.42.75 lakhs. About 40% of the total work have been completed. M/S. Dulal Mukhenet and Associates was paid an amount of Rs.5.19.304/- as Consultancy charges.

Hostels

The plans submitted by the consultant for two hostels - one Boys' (Capacity-198) and another ladies' (Capacity-56) were approved by the Works Advisory Committee and sanctioned by the local (Baranagar) Municipality. Soil tests were completed at the two sites. The Consultant, M/S. Prabir Mitra, has submitted draft price schedules for the two buildings which are under scrutiny.

D-type Quarter

M/S. Ghosh-Bose and Associates Pvt. Ltd. was selected as Consultant for the project. The plans submitted by the Consultant were sanctioned by the Baranagar Municipality against fee of Rs. 22,703/-. The draft price schedule for the project, submitted by the Consultant, is presently under scrutiny.

Renovation of Sudhir Bhavan

The allocated fund was diverted for incurring expenditure on sanction of plans for hostels, soil-testing, construction of roads inside the institute campus and urgent maintenance works in new guest house.

Fitting and Fixtures of A-type quarter

The scheme for providing wooden fittings as Cupboards, racks etc. in the various flats of the newly constructed A-type quarter was developed departmentally and the same was approved by the Works Advisory Committee. The job was awarded to M/S. Carlie-Lawrie for an amount of Rs.12.70 lakhs. About 65% of the total work have been completed.

Miscellaneous Constructions

Various renovation/repair/facelifting works at the office buildings, residential Quarters, Hostels et were carried out during the current year. The allocated fund was used up in these various works at the different premises of the Institute.

Delhi

The construction of four transit flats, two halls, (faculty lounge and community hall), (except finishing and furnishing) three underground tanks and one approach road for transit flat were completed.

Under the SQC Development Fund with the sanctioned budget of Rs.3.60 lakhs a conference hall for SOC is renovated.

Bangalore

Construction of four class rooms-cum-lab. Furnishing and Interior decoration of Auditorium accommodating 30-60 persons. Completion of construction of 60% Guest House work, which is under construction since December 2000.

Fmance Committee Meeting: The Finance Committee met twice, on 1 September 2000 and 01 November 2000, during the period under report. Apart from taking various decisions on financial matters, the committee recummended RE 2000-2001 and BE 2001-2002 (Plan and Non-Plan) in their meeting on 1 September 2000 and considered and recommended the Annual Report including Audited Statement of Accounts for the year 1999-2000 in their meeting held on 1 November 2000.

Council Meeting: The Council met seven times during the period under report to take decisions on administrative and scientific matters. In the Council meeting held on 4 November 2000, the budget proposate both for Plan and Non-Plan (RE for 2000-2001 and BE for 2001-2002) as recommended by the Finance Committee in its meeting held on 1 September 2000. In the meeting dated 4 November 2000 the Annual Report including the Audited Statement of Accounts for the year 1999-2000 were considered by the Council and was approved.

A list containing the names of the President of the Institute, Chairman and members of the Council of the Institute and also a list of members of different committees constituted by the Council are given elsewhere in the report.

Annual General Meeting: The General Body of the Institute met on 17 November 2000 during the period under report. The Annual Report of the Institute for the year 1999-2000 and Audited Statement of Accounts for the year 1999-2000 together with the Auditor's comments and replies of the Administration thereto were adopted to the meeting of the General Body on 17 November 2000.
