Budget and Finance

For the year 2003-2004 the Institute's budget was estimated to be Rs.4317.20 lakhs and Rs.1584.00 lakhs towards Non-Plan and Plan respectively at the BE stage. The Government, after considering the report of the Section 8(1) Committee, approved a sum of Rs.4208.55 lakhs including internal receipts and Rs.150.00 lakhs for Non-Plan and Plan expenditure respectively. At the revised estimate stage,

the Institute sought for a grant of Rs.4286.25 takhs and Rs.1579.00 takhs in Non-Plan and Plan estimates respectively. The Government approved a sum of Rs.4213.69 takhs on Non-Plan, the Plan RE allocation was fixed at Rs.1579.00 takhs. The expenditure uting the year under report was well within the budget allocation sanctioned by the Government. The Audited Annual Accounts of the institute for the year 2003-2004 have been furnished in Part IV of this report.

Construction and Maintenance works

The following major activities were undertaken by the Institute during 2003-2004.

Kolkata

Academic Building Phase-1

The construction work of Academic Building Phase-1 by M/s. Larsen & Toubro Ltd. has been completed and the interior partitioning along with internal electrification and airconditioning work is in progress. The building is expected to be occupied by September 2004.

An amount of Rs.165.42 lakhs was paid in this year to various agencies working for the above building.

Boys' & Girls' Hostels

The construction work of the above hostel blocks is virtually completed and taking over of the building is in progress.

An amount of Rs.229.61 lakhs has been paid to the Contractor Ws. Larsen and Toubro and consultancy charges to Ws. P. Mitra.

D-Type Quarters

The work is completed and the building has been taken over by the ISI and allotted to the eligible workers for residence.

An amount of Rs.29.89 lakhs has been paid to Contractor M/s. Larsen and Toubro in this financial year.

Boundary Wall

The boundary wall along the GLT Road is under construction and an amount of Rs.20.17 lakts has been paid to Contractor Ws. Ghosh Engineering Pvt. Ltd. in this financial year and work will be completed by the end of August 2004.

Underground Pedestrian Subway

The construction of the subway is in full swing and will be completed by the end of July 2004. An amount of Rs.27.71 lakhs has been paid to the Contractor Ms. Traders and Engineers Pvt. Ltd. in this financial year.

Renovation work at Amrapali

The renovation work under phase-1 is in progress. An amount of Rs.3.60 lakhs has been paid to Contractor M/s. Nu-Pragathi and the work will be completed by the end of August 2004.

Miscellaneous

Various renovation/repair works were carried out during the year 2003-2004 at various Office Buildings. Residential Quarters and Hostel Blocks of ISI Carnous.
