Budget and Finance

For the year 2006-2007, Section 8(1) Committee recommended Rs.4757.10 lakhs (Government Grant Rs.4577.10 lakhs and ISI internal receipt Rs.180 lakhs) under Non-Plan (BE) and Rs.1669 lakhs under Plan (BE). The Government approved a sum of Rs.4419.73 lakhs (net) and of Rs.1600.00 lakhs for Non-Plan and Plan expenditure respectively. At the revised estimate stage, the Institute sought for a grant of Rs.4753.30 lakhs and Rs.1600.00 lakhs under Non-Plan and Plan respectively which was also recommended by the Section 8(1) Committee. The Government sanctioned a grant of Rs.4743.49 lakhs (including the unutilized amount of Rs.64.55 lakhs during the financial year 2005-2009) under Non-Plan and the Plen allocation was fixed at Rs.1592.00 lakhs (including the unutilized amount of

Rs.205.82 lakhs during the financial year 2005-2006). The expenditure during the year under report was well within the budget allocation sanctioned by the Government. The Audited Annual Accounts of the Institute for the year 2006-2007 have been furnished in Part IV of this report.

Major Construction / renovation works taken up by the institute during 2006-07

Kolkata

During the period (2006-2007), the Baranagar Works Advisory Committee (BWAC) met four times on 07th June 2006, 29th June 2006, 07th August 2006 and 17th January 2007 to advise and overview the following construction activities:

Construction of Platinum Jubilee Academic Building at ISI

The Institute has taken up the work of construction work of Platinum Jubilee Academic Building Phase I work which includes the structural work of the building. The total work value is Rs.5.5.1.18.564. The piling work is completed & the ground floor roof slab has been casted. The work is in progress.

An amount of Rs.147.94 lakhs has been paid to the concerned agency along with consultancy fees.

Construction of 'D' type Quarters Building at ISI

The construction work of 0 type quarter (G-3) has been taken up with an amount of Rs.78,73,763.53 at Deluxe Garden Campus. The roof slab for the first floor slab has already been completed. The work is in progress. It is expected to complete by November 2007.

An amount of Rs.16.97 lakhs has already been paid to the agency including consultancy charges.

An amount of Rs.34.87 lakhs has already been paid to the concerned agencies including consultancy charges in this financial year.

The work of completion renovation of the Dean's Office & class room at 5th & 7th floor was taken up and completed in all respects.

An amount of Rs.13.23 lakhs has been paid to the agency for the complete work during this financial year.

Re-construction of boundary wall at 202 B.T. Road campus along G.L.T. Road at ISI

The part of the reconstruction of boundary wall at 202 along GLT Road was taken up and completed in all respects,

An amount of Rs.10.21 lakhs has been paid to the agency for the complete work during this financial year.

AUDITORS' REPORT TO INDIAN STATISTICAL INSTITUTE

- 1. We have audited the attached Balance Sheet as at 31st March, 2007 of INDIAN STATISTICAL INSTITUTE (Institute), an Institute of National Importance, registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 and established under the Indian Statistical Institute Act, 1959 and also the Income & Expenditure Account of the Institute for the year ended on that date annexed thereto. These financial statements are the responsibility of the management of the Institute. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.
- 2. We conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in India. Those Standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall financial statement presentation. We believe that our audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.
- 3. Attention is invited to our following comments:
- 3.1 The Institute has not yet got the tax exemption u/s 10 of the Income Tax Act, 1961 for its income for the financial year 2006-07 and as such we are unable to comment on Institute's income tax liability, if any for the year under audit.
- 3.2 The Institute falls within the definition of "Employer" as prescribed u/s 115W of the Income Tax Act, 1961 and as such liable to pay Fringe Benefit Tax u/s 115WA of the said Act. No payment or provision for such tax is made in the accounts (amount of liability including arrear liability is not ascertained by the management).

- 3.3 No depreciation for the financial year 1986-87 and onwards has been provided in the accounts on the fixed assets acquired up to the financial year 1985-86.
- 3.4 Allocation of grant between capital and revenue out of plan grant and allocation of revenue expenditure between plan and non-plan grant are made by the institute.
- 3.5 Indian Statistical Institute, New Delhi Centre has not followed the General Financial Rules, 2005 with regard to construction/ renovation of its building.
- 3.6 Purchase & Exp. on Giridih Agricultural Farm does not Include other related expenses, which are allocated to other heads of account.
- Previous year's figures are audited and reported upon by the previous auditors.

5. We report that:

- (a) We have obtained all the information and explanations, which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purposes of our audit;
- (b) In our opinion, proper books of account as required by law have been kept by the Institute so far as appears from our examination of those books:
- (c) The Balance Sheet and the Income & Expenditure Account dealt with by this report are in agreement with the books of account;

- (d) In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us the financial statements read together with the notes thereon and subject to our comments in Para 3 above give a true and fair view in conformity with the accounting principles generally accepted in India:
 - (i) in the case of the Balance Sheet, of the state of affairs of the Institute as at 31st March, 2007; and
 - (ii) in the case of the Income & Expenditure Account, of the excess of income over expenditure for the year ended on that date.
