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DISTRIBUTION OF MUSLIMS IN THE POPULATION OF INDIA ; 1941.

The accompanying map and tables supply material for a factual study of the distribution of Muslims in India. Eight different shades of colour have been employed to indicate different intensities of Muslims in the population. The whole range (of 100 per cent) has been divided into eight classes each representing an interval of two-anna (or $12\frac{1}{2}\%$) of the total population, and one colour has been assigned to each class.

Deep blue represents the highest intensity of Muslims of 14 anna (or $87\frac{1}{2}\%$ and above,) light blue indicates a Muslim population between 12-anna and 14-anna (between 75% and $87\frac{1}{2}\%$), green between 10-anna and 12-anna ($62\frac{1}{2}\%$ and 75%), and light green between 8-anna and 10-anna (between 50% and $62\frac{1}{2}\%$) of Muslims.

Orange and red indicate areas in which Muslims form less than 50% of the population. Light orange shows a Muslim proportion between 6-anna and 8-anna ($37\frac{1}{2}\%$ and 50%); orange between 4-anna and 6-anna (25% and $37\frac{1}{2}\%$); light red between 2-anna and 4-anna ($12\frac{1}{2}\%$ and 25%) of Muslims ; and finally red represents areas in which Muslims form 2-anna ($12\frac{1}{2}\%$) or less of the total population.

The tables give by Districts in the different Provinces and States of India, the total population in thousands (col. 2) according to the Indian Census of 1941. The percentage of Muslims is shown in Col. (3) ; the percentage of Hindus in Col. (4) ; and the percentage of 'Others' (which includes tribal groups) in col. (5).

Assam, as a whole, is not a Muslim-majority province, as will be evident from the map itself. The only Muslim-majority region in it is the district of Sylhet which has been numbered and shown in the list of districts given in the lower left-hand side of the map.
